Teaneck Creek Conservancy Supports County of Bergen Department of Parks Restoration

TEANECK, NJ (August 7, 2018) -- Teaneck Creek Conservancy fully supports County of Bergen Department of Parks restoration plan for Area 1 of Overpeck County Park System, known as Teaneck Creek Park located in Teaneck, NJ.

Teaneck Creek Conservancy is excited for the long-anticipated restoration, which includes removing debris, reestablishing water flow across the site, and creating a first-of-its-kind regenerative storm water conveyance approach for Teaneck Creek Park.

"The vision for Teaneck Creek, established 17 years ago by our Founder Perry Rosenstein, has been to preserve the environmental integrity of the 46 acres maintained by the Conservancy," says Alexa Marques, Executive Director of Teaneck Creek Conservancy. "The restoration of Area 1 has the full support of the Board of Directors and we look forward to the future for our park."
